Like all physical activities, dance lessons have a specific dress code for several reasons; most importantly, our required attire allows for the body to move freely and for our teachers to clearly see the movements our students are making, allowing positive feedback to be given to our dancers. Additionally, dance has a long-standing tradition of its very specific attire, and like other art forms such as martial arts, it is imperative that as dancers we honor this tradition and dress accordingly each and every time we come to class. Swimsuits, gymnastics leos, gym shorts, etc. are not considered proper dance attire - just as a ballet leotard and tights are not acceptable in other activities.

We understand that occasionally dancers (or parents) forget to pack the proper attire. We will kindly remind dancers of our dress code, and if it is apparent that it has become a problem, we will contact parents to assure that all dancers are dressed properly for class.

### Premier Prep Dress Code

**Girls:** BLACK leotard, pink (or skin tone for brown-skinned dancers) tights & ballet shoes (leather or canvas) /pointe shoes, tan tap shoes, tan jazz shoes. Hair in a neat ballet bun for ballet class, hair secured away from face and neck for jazz and tap.

**Boys:** WHITE t-shirt, solid color shorts or sweatpants, black ballet shoes (leather or canvas), black tap shoes, black jazz shoes.
